Why we collect and use this information

We collect and use personal data to share details about Neighbourhood Watch and crime information, local events and notices affecting the village.

The categories of information that we collect, process and hold and share include:

We only hold your name and email address.

The lawful basis on which we process this information

We process this information under Article 6(1)(a) of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), consent.

Collecting this information

If you wish to receive emails as detailed above, you provide your name and email address to us, confirming your consent.

Storing this information

We hold personal data electronically only, until you advise us that you wish to be removed from the list. After that, all electronic records will be deleted immediately.

Who we share this information with

We do not share this information with anyone.

Requesting access to your personal data

You have the following rights in relation to our processing of your data:

- the right to be informed;
- the right of access;
